### Why is this campaign so important to The Jenkins School?

The long-term future looks bright for The Jenkins School, but the school needs some financial help in the short run (next one to two years) to overcome cash flow shortages resulting from the move off of the Millersville University campus. We've got a new home and we have costs associated with the move – some were anticipated, and others were not. The school seeks to grow in size and in service. This will require marketing and financial aid support to do so. The school seeks to add more accessible and up-to-date technology to its curriculum. The school wants to plant the seeds for a permanent endowment – one that will grow in size and impact over the years – to help ensure a more stable financial future.

### Is the move off of Millersville University's campus a good thing or not for the future of The Jenkins School?

While most would have preferred to stay on campus, our children, families and staff did not have a choice. The wonderful new building and location keeps us very close to our roots in Millersville, but it also exposes us to a much larger pool of future students and families in Lancaster, Mountville, Hempfield and beyond.
